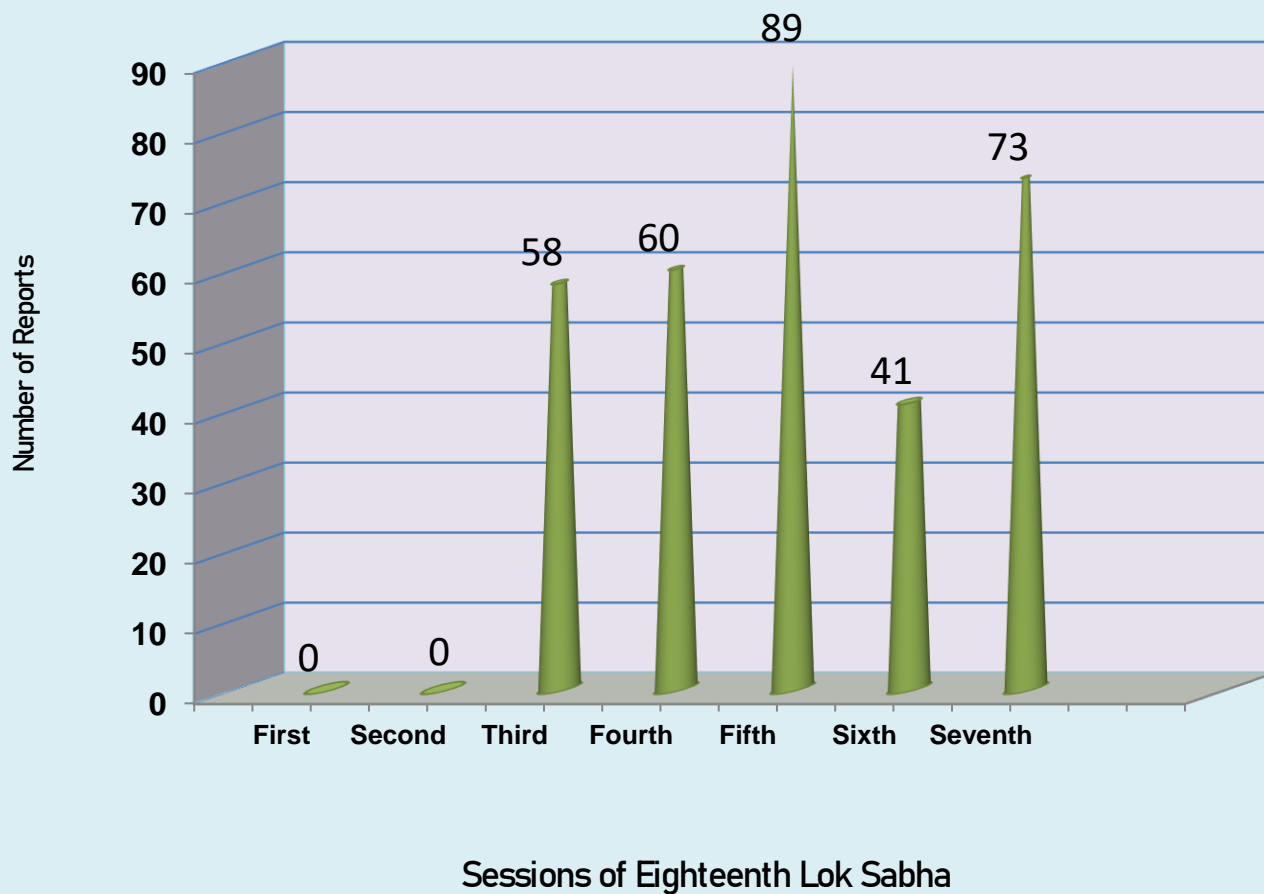

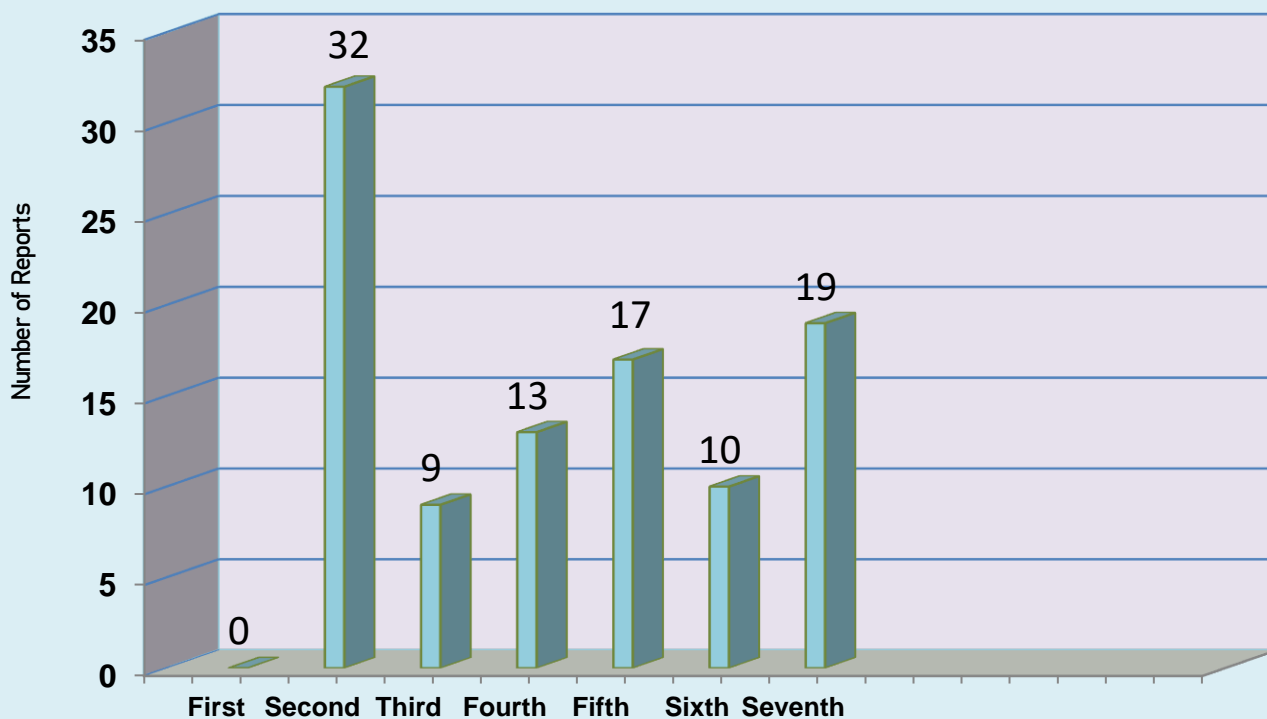
**Number of Reports by Departmentally Related Standing Committees**

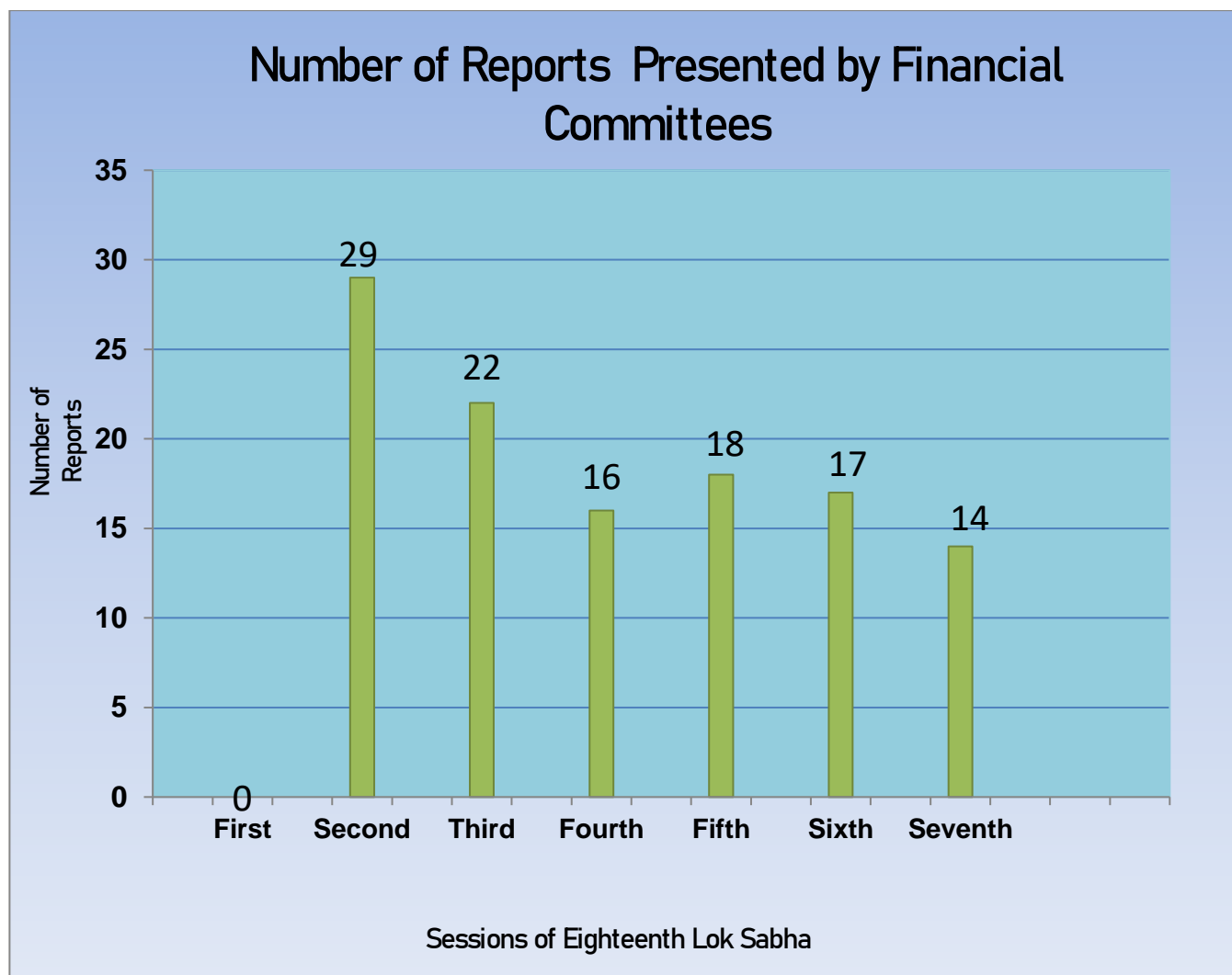
**Number of Reports Presented by Parliamentary

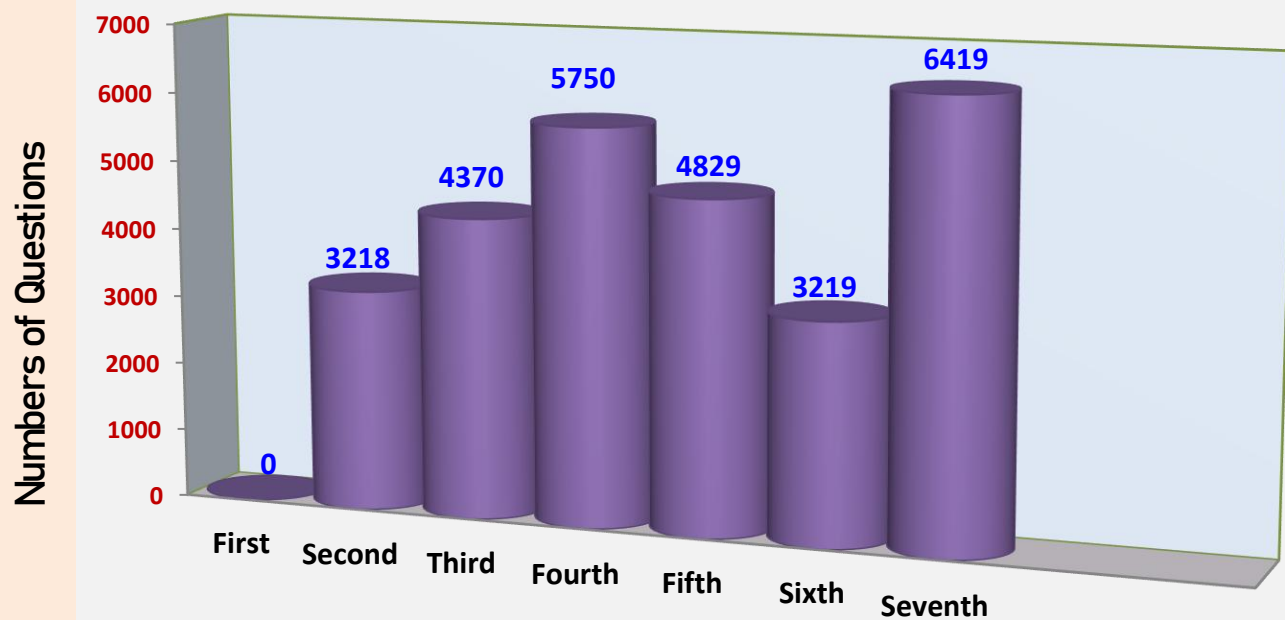
